- Municipal Code City vs. Second Class City
Scott Thomas, City of Burlington, City Attorney discussed the City of Burlington's experience in transition from a Second Class City to a Code City. Numerous questions and discussion ensued. More discussion to take place at the City Council meeting.
- Stormwater
Scott Thomas, City of Burlington, City Attorney discussed the City of Burlington's stormwater policy and their lawsuit (joint with other cities). Washington State's law exceeds Federal requirements and the lawsuit wants the requirements relaxed to the Federal level. Discussed method of determining residential and commercial rates, ERU's, etc. (high-low ranges).
- Personnel Policies Manual Update
Discussed general policy, statements, etc.
- Miscellaneous Updates
 - Railroad – doesn't want to sell due to county rail bank. Discussed permit method (Councilmember Meamber arrived) of sewer installation: trench, casings, grade, etc.
 - Truck Vault access issues were discussed.
