Council Worksession
April 6, 2010 – 7:00 P.M. – Fire Training Room

Mayor Anderson called the meeting to order at 7:00 P.M. with the Flag Salute.

ROLL CALL: Present: Mayor Mike Anderson, Councilmembers: Ted Meamber, Tony Splane, Tom Storrs, Pat Colgan, Hugh Galbraith, Rick Lemley and Brett Sandström.

Staff: City Supervisor/Attorney Berg, Finance Director Nelson and Director of Public Works/City Engineer Freiburger, Public Works Operations Supervisor Walley.

Planning Commission Appointment

- Mayor Anderson introduced Jennifer Aylor Eldred as a candidate for the position of Planning Commissioner. He requested Council confirm her appointment.

Councilmember Colgan moved to confirm the Mayor's appointment of Jennifer Aylor Eldred to the Planning Commission. Seconded by Councilmember Storrs.

Councilmember Sandström disclosed that Eldred was his neighbor. Motion carried 7-0.

Public Works Operations 2010 Work Program

- Director of Public Works/City Engineer Freiburger reviewed proposed projects as shown on a City map and detailed memo. He also addressed staffing issues due to budget cuts and indicated they are doing more with less. He noted that mowing and special requests might not get done during construction periods.
- Freiburger noted he will be completing an application to TIB for the Jameson St/SR9 project. The funding for the SR20 Widening status is currently unknown. Applications for sidewalk extension on N. Township from Lucas to Fire Station 2, Burlington Northern Trestle widening/heightening and Cook road redirection are underway.

Open Air Mobile Vendors

- Mayor Anderson introduced the issue of Open Air Mobile Vendors and explained the background. Discussion followed.

Miscellaneous Items

- It was noted that both Mayor Anderson and Mayor Pro-Tem Storrs will be absent from the next Council meeting. Councilmember Meamber will run the meeting and attend the Tuesday morning staff meeting.
- Mayor Anderson discussed the upcoming Complete Streets conference and requested Council consider attending.
- Engineer Freiburger discussed the extension of sewer from Maple Street to SR9 and Critter Lane and possible funding mechanisms.

Councilmember Colgan moved to adjourn. Seconded by All. Motion carried (7-0).
