

Situation:

On Friday, September 25th the bids were opened for the 100+ ft. aerial device better known as the "ladder truck". We were very lucky to have 3 bidders. I have attached the bid results to this memo.

After reviewing all the bid, I am recommending that the city award the bid to Rosenbauer/General Fire of Spokane, WA in the amount of 743,807.65 (which includes taxes).

We chose Rosenbauer/General Fire over H & W because the H & W bid was non-responsive. The H & W bid was for a used 2008 demo and it did not have many of the features that we spec'ed out in the vehicle.

Recommended Action:

Staff recommends that the City Council authorize the Mayor to sign the purchase agreement with Rosenbauer/General Fire for the purchase of a 109 ft. aerial apparatus.
