

# **Mayor Anderson's statement on the passing of lifelong Sedro-Woolley resident Max Always**

SEDRO-WOOLLEY – Mayor Mike Anderson issued the following statement today on the passing of longtime Sedro-Woolley resident, Max Always:

“Max was a fixture in Sedro-Woolley for years and years and years. A frequent participant at city council and school board meetings, Max was very engaged in the political process, even running for office a number of times.”

“Max self-published a number of books which he distributed around town, all centered around his philosophical beliefs. I'll never forget how news crews would somehow manage to find Max anytime Sedro-Woolley was featured on television. With his death, Max's favorite bench in downtown Woolley will never be the same. I'll miss him.”

Max died today at the age of 82. His family is expected to release an obituary soon.
