The City of Sedro-Woolley announces the scheduling of a public voter education forum for candidates standing for election in this November's general election. Specifically, candidates for contested Skagit County offices are participating, including: assessor, auditor, treasurer, coroner, commissioner and PUD commissioner.

The forum is hosted by the City of Sedro-Woolley and will take place at 6:00 P.M. at the City Council Chambers, 325 Metcalf Street, on October 15, 2014.

Questions from the audience will be taken through a moderator. Voters and interested members of the community are invited and encouraged to attend. The Sedro-Woolley City Council was concerned about a lack of opportunity to meet and hear from candidates and according to Mayor Anderson, "I have always appreciated the League of Women Voters for their forums; we are stepping in to provide a similar forum since they are no longer able to support one in eastern Skagit County. I really hope voters take the time come and listen to their candidates."

The event will be audio and video recorded and made available on the City's website. The Council Chambers are ADA accessible, including the availability of assisted listening devices.
